NOTIFICATION

The West Bengal Health Scheme (WBHS) was introduced in 2009 to provide healthcare facilities to serving as well as retired Government employees and their dependent beneficiaries. Subsequently, the cashless IPD (In-Patient Department) treatment facility was introduced in 2014. However, the approved rates under WBHS were last revised more than a decade ago and have remained unchanged since then despite significant escalation in healthcare costs.

Due to the prolonged non-revision of approved rates, beneficiaries are facing difficulties in availing IPD & OPD treatment from empanelled Healthcare Organizations (HCOs) at the prevailing rates. It is felt that, in order to ensure continuity of the Scheme in the interest of serving & retired employees, a rational revision of WBHS approved rates in line with prevailing healthcare costs and comparable benchmarks such as Central Government Health Scheme (CGHS) is necessary.

Accordingly, in view of the above and after careful consideration of the matter, the Governor is pleased to notify the revised approved rates for various services, procedures, investigations etc. required in connection with medical attendance and treatment of a beneficiary under WBHS subject to the following terms & conditions and associated guidelines:

1. Structure of Differential Rates:

The empanelled HCOs are classified into three categories based on geographical locations, viz. **X (Tier-I)**, **Y (Tier-II)**, and **Z (Tier-III)**. Revised approved rates have been rationalised based on such classification and the existing HCO class under the scheme:

- i. The approved rates applicable to HCOs located in **Y (Tier-II)** cities shall be **10%** lower, and those applicable to HCOs located in **Z (Tier-III)** cities shall be **20%** lower than the approved rates applicable to HCOs located in **X (Tier-I)** cities.
- ii. HCOs classified as **Class-I** shall be entitled to **100%** of the approved rates notified for their respective city classification, while HCOs classified as **Class-II** shall be entitled to **80%** of the approved rates notified for their respective city classification.
- iii. In cases where treatment is received in non-empanelled HCOs, the existing provision for reimbursement at 80% or 60% of the approved rate, as applicable, shall continue to apply. The approved rate shall be determined based on the city classification applicable to the regional location of the concerned HCO.

Note: **X (Tier-I)** cities include the **Kolkata Metropolitan Area** as defined in the Calcutta Metropolitan Planning Area (Use and Development of Land) Control Act, 1965, along with subsequent amendment if any; **Y (Tier-II)** cities include **Asansol, Durgapur and Siliguri**; and **Z (Tier-III)** comprises the rest of West Bengal, or as may be determined by the competent authority from time to time. The existing guidelines regarding the classification of HCOs as **Class-I** or **Class-II** shall continue to be followed.

2. Adaptation of CGHS Rates for Procedures, Investigations and Implants under WBHS:

The latest CGHS rates, as notified from time to time, for procedures, investigations and implants have been adapted under WBHS. Accordingly, the existing WBHS approved rates have been revised, and new procedures, investigations and implants available under CGHS have also been incorporated into the WBHS maximum approved rates. The revised approved rates are specified

in **Annexure-I**, appended to this notification, and are also available on the WBHS website: <https://healthscheme.wb.gov.in>.

The WBHS approved rates shall, as a general rule, be revised from time to time to remain at par with the corresponding CGHS rates, subject to the following exceptions:

- i. Where the existing WBHS approved rate in respect of any category viz procedure, investigation or implant is higher than the corresponding CGHS rate, such higher WBHS approved rate shall continue to apply, and shall not be reduced to align with the lower CGHS rate.
- ii. In respect of Tata Medical Centre, Rajarhat; Chittaranjan National Cancer Institute (CNCI), Rajarhat; and Woodburn Ward, IPGME&R-SSKM, Kolkata — being institutions governed by separate Memoranda of Agreement (MoA), the approved rates applicable shall be as per the respective MoA, and not the CGHS-linked rates notified herein.

3. Adaptation of CGHS Guidelines and Definitions under WBHS:

The Supporting Guidelines and Definitions for implementation of the revised approved rates and newly introduced rates under the West Bengal Health Scheme are specified in **Annexure - II, III and IV** appended to this notification.

4. Implementation of revised and newly added rates:

The revised approved rates shall come into effect from the **1st day of September, 2026**, and shall apply to all IPD treatments where the date of admission is on or after the said date, and to all OPD consultations/investigations etc. undertaken on or after the said date.

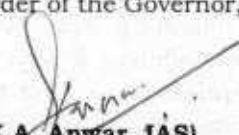
OPD consultations and reimbursement thereof shall be confined to the diseases as currently allowed under WBHS, subject to any future amendment in this regard.

The revised approved rates of WBHS shall apply to all Healthcare Organisations (HCOs) and all Diagnostic Centres empanelled under the WBHS, excluding the institutions specified in clause - 2 (ii) above, viz. Tata Medical Centre, Rajarhat; Chittaranjan National Cancer Institute (CNCI), Rajarhat; and Woodburn Ward, IPGME&R-SSKM, Kolkata, which shall continue to be governed by their respective Memoranda of Agreement.

All earlier orders, notifications, guidelines, instructions, or clarifications issued on the subject shall stand modified to the extent they are inconsistent with the provisions of this Notification.

This issues with the approval of the Competent Authority vide UO No. CMO/26/JS-1/F-D/230 dated 01.07.2026.

Revised Guidelines for empanelled Health Care Organisations for Medical Treatment under the West Bengal Health Scheme

- 1. Definition of WBHS Package Rate:** The WBHS Package Rate shall be construed as an all-inclusive lump sum cost, applicable from the time of admission to the time of discharge, encompassing the entire treatment cycle of an inpatient/day care/diagnostic procedure for which the WBHS beneficiary has been permitted treatment. The package rate includes but is not limited to the following:
- Accommodation charges, including the patient's diet
 - Admission charges
 - Anaesthesia charges
 - Cost of medicines and consumables/disposables
 - Cost of surgical disposables and all sundries used during hospitalization
 - Doctor/consultant visit charges
 - Dressing charges
 - ICU/ICCU charges
 - Injection charges
 - Monitoring charges
 - Nursing care charges
 - O2 charges, Ventilator charges as routinely required, if any, etc.
 - Operation charges
 - Operation theatre charges
 - Physiotherapy charges, etc.
 - Procedural charges/surgeon's fee
 - Registration charges
 - Related routine and essential investigations during the admission of the patient
 - Transfusion charges and Blood processing charges
 - Equipment Charges including Flowtron, Infusion pump, syringe pump etc.
- Uniformity of Rates for In-House and Outsourced Services - The WBHS package rates shall apply uniformly, irrespective of whether the services (diagnostic, laboratory, imaging, physiotherapy, or any clinical service) are provided in-house by the hospital or outsourced to an external service provider. Hospitals shall not charge or seek reimbursement beyond the prescribed WBHS package rate under the pretext of outsourced service provision. No differential pricing shall be applied for outsourced services.
 - Package rates envisage up to a maximum duration of indoor treatment as follows:
 - i. Up to 12 days for Specialised (Super Specialties) treatment

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- ii. Up to 7 days for other Major Surgeries
- iii. Up to 3 days for Laparoscopic surgeries / elective Angioplasty / normal deliveries and
- iv. 1 day for day care / Minor (OPD) surgeries.
- During in-patient treatment of the WBHS beneficiary, the hospital will not ask the beneficiary or his/her attendant to purchase separately the medicines / sundries / equipment or accessories from outside and will provide the treatment within the package rate, fixed by the WBHS, which includes the cost of all the items.

2. Implants and Consumables:

- Implants such as lenses, stents, meshes, and valves are reimbursable in addition to the package rates as per WBHS ceiling rates.
- Unlisted implants will be reimbursed based on the actual invoice or as per NPPA (National Pharmaceutical Pricing Authority) rates, whichever is less.
- All consumables and medicines, including guide wires and catheters, are deemed inclusive in the package rate.
- Drug-eluting balloon used in lieu of a stent is payable as per NPPA rates or actual invoice whichever is less.

Note: Implant rates apply uniformly across all city categories and all HCO classifications.

3. Chemotherapy Charges:

- The package rate for chemotherapy includes procedural charges only.
- Room rent, investigations, and anti-cancer medicines are reimbursable in addition to the procedural charges.

4. Unlisted Procedures and Investigations:

The current guidelines for Unlisted Procedures and Investigations shall continue.

5. Multiple Surgical Procedures in One OT Session:

- When multiple surgeries are performed in a single operative session:
 - The primary procedure (with the highest package rate) shall be reimbursed at 100%.
 - The second procedure shall be reimbursed at 50% of its package rate.
 - The third and subsequent procedures shall be reimbursed at 25% of their respective package rates.

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- If identical surgeries are performed at different anatomical sites (e.g., bilateral cataract or bilateral knee replacement), the second procedure will be reimbursed at 50%.
- Where any additional procedure is performed during the same admission and within the package period of an earlier procedure, such additional procedure shall be reimbursed at 75% of the applicable package rate.
- Individual steps of a procedure must not be itemised or charged separately. All integral steps are deemed included within the package. The package must fully cover the scope of the procedure as per standard clinical protocols.
- Normally, not more than two packages shall be performed or planned during a single admission. Prior approval of the Medical Cell shall be required for undertaking more than two packages, irrespective of the cost of the procedures.

6. Consultation:

- The consultation fee is inclusive of the cost of examination consumables such as paper gloves, unsterile gloves, or examination gloves, if used during the examination of the patient.

Note: Consultation rates apply uniformly across all city categories.

7. In non-surgical (medical management) cases:

- Expenses incurred on medicines, consumables, sundry accessories, etc., which are purchased from outside, based on specific authorisation of

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treating doctor/staff of the concerned hospital will be reimbursable if they are not falling under the list of non-admissible items. In case the empanelled hospital has asked a WBHS beneficiary for purchase of the said item over and above the package rates, reimbursement shall be made to the beneficiary and the amount shall be recovered from the pending bills of hospital.

- Antibiotic policy (of the hospital) must be followed and care should be taken for judicious use of high-end antibiotics including anti-fungal agents. High-end antibiotics, including antifungal agents should preferably be used on recommendations of a Committee constituted for the same.
- There are prescribed guidelines for use of IV Albumin and they should be adhered to.
- Disposable items must be utilised in optimum quantity.
- Medicine is a branch of science and it should be practiced scientifically only.
 - Investigations and treatment provided to the patient must be based on the differential diagnosis and provisional diagnosis arrived at on the basis of complaints, history of the patient and clinical examination findings which must be documented.
 - Investigations which are repeated must add value to the treatment or commensurate with the treatment.
 - Well established form of therapy should be used. Procedure/ drug on trial should not be used.
 - If a new or newer form of drug / procedure is used, it should be specifically indicated for that particular patient because of the decisive superiority over the existing drug / procedure.

Annexure-III

Description of Ward categories, Nursing care charges, ICU and Critical Care Unit Charges, Equipment Charges

1. Ward Categories

Room rent or ward charges are consolidated charges and shall comprehensively include the following components (but not limited to):

- I. Accommodation charges and medical record charges
- II. Nursing care charges (inclusive as detailed below)
- III. Registration and admission charges
- IV. Welcome kit
- V. Air bed, water bed, alpha bed, etc.
- VI. Air conditioning/HVAC charges
- VII. Electricity and water charges
- VIII. Housekeeping services
- IX. Infection control services
- X. Biomedical waste management
- XI. Portable/bedside/emergency services
- XII. Laundry services
- XIII. Patient identification bands, bed sheets, patient gown
- XIV. Visitor passes
- XV. Resident doctor charges
- XVI. Diet and dietician services
- XVII. Issue of discharge summary, investigation reports, warranty cards, outer pouches of implants, stickers.

The above elements are considered integral to the room rent and must not be charged separately under any circumstances.

2. Nursing Care Charges

Nursing care forms an essential part of the ward package and shall include, but is not limited to, the following services:

- I. Medication administration (oral, IV, IM)
- II. IV cannulation and infusion management
- III. Ambulation/mobilization of patient
- IV. Ryle's tube feeding and enteral nutrition support
- V. Care of catheters (urinary, ICD, central lines, etc.)
- VI. Wound and bed sore care
- VII. Tracheostomy care and oral hygiene
- VIII. Personal hygiene and sponge bathing
- IX. Patient monitoring and recording
- X. Health education to patient and/or caregiver

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Nursing care charges are bundled in the ward charges and therefore not payable separately or billable to the patient.

3. ICU and Critical Care Unit Charges:

Critical care services (ICU/CCU/ICCU/PICU/MICU/NICU/SNCU/ITU/HDU etc.) shall be considered standardised units with an inclusive package that covers:

- I. All medical and nursing care as described above in point 1 & 2 in the critical care setting
- II. Monitoring, equipment, oxygen support, infection control, Nursing care assistance, and other ICU-specific consumables and services Standard ICU charges per day.

Note: ICU rates apply uniformly across all city categories.

4. Equipment Charges

Charges related to the use of medical equipment during inpatient or surgical procedures shall be considered inclusive within room rent or procedural package rates. These include:

- C-arm, surgical OT equipment
- DVT pump, infusion pump
- Portable X-ray or bedside diagnostics
- Attendant bed (in case of private and higher ward entitlement)
- Any other machine or device used during the patient's stay or surgery
- Separate billing for equipment usage is not permitted

Annexure-IV
(Notification No. 70-F(MED)/WB, dated 14.08.2026)

Admissible and Non-Admissible Items (Billing Guidelines)

This annexure provides clarification on items and charges that are includable or excludable in bills as per WBHS. The HCO must adhere to these when billing WBHS or WBHS beneficiaries.

- 1. Admissible Consumables and Materials:** Common medical consumables (cotton, gauze, gloves, syringes, needles, catheters, IV sets, tubing, dressing materials, etc.)
 - a. These items are considered part of the treatment package for surgical procedures and are included in respective package rates. No separate charge for such items is admissible in bills of surgical packages.
 - b. In non-surgical (medical management) cases where no package rate exists, reasonable use of consumables is allowed and can be billed under consumables head. The HCO must ensure rational use of all consumables. Billing for extraordinarily high quantities without clinical need will be viewed seriously as potential inflation and penalised.
 - c. Vague billing entries like “consumables kit” or “procedure kit” without specifics (e.g., “lumbar puncture kit”, “dressing kit”, and “nebulisation kit”) are not acceptable. Such items shall be disallowed.
- 2. Non-Admissible Items:** The following categories of items shall not be reimbursed by WBHS, and the amount may be collected from beneficiary:
 - a. Toiletries and Personal Use Items: e.g. soap, shampoo, toothbrush, toothpaste, comb, sanitary pads, diapers, hand sanitizers for personal use, mouthwash, tissue papers, etc. (These are considered personal hygienic items and not part of treatment costs.)
 - b. Cosmetics and Other Miscellaneous Personal Items: e.g. razors/shaving blades, beauty creams, powders, deodorants, oils (like coconut oil), talcum powder, makeup items, etc.
 - c. Non-Medical Services/Overheads: e.g. telephone charges for patient calls, bedside television charges, internet fees, patient’s attendant food, hospital gown for attendant, carry bags for medicines or belongings, etc. (Basic cost of a patient's own gown/drapes is included in ward charge, but if a hospital bills a kit, it is not reimbursable).
 - d. Attendant Charges: Any charge for providing an attendant (ayah / ward boy) specifically to the patient or charges for extra bedding for the attendant (except one attendant bed included in a private ward) are not reimbursable. Professional nursing care is separate and included in the ward charges.
 - e. Mortuary or Cremation charges: If a patient expires, any charge like mortuary fee or transportation for last rites are not covered WBHS expense.
 - f. Extra Bedding/Blankets beyond norm: already included in ward charges; cannot charge separately.

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- g. Implant Upgrades: If the patient opts for an implant or prosthesis of higher value than what WBHS covers, the difference in cost would not be reimbursable. The beneficiary may decide to bear that difference, with prior consent. Such differences should not be billed to WBHS/claimed.

Note: In summary, anything that is not directly related to treatment and is primarily for patient convenience or personal preference is non-admissible.

3. Inadmissible Additional Charges: The HCO shall not separately bill for the following components, as they are considered part of standard charges for related services. Hence, these are neither to be billed to WBHS nor amounts to be collected from Beneficiaries:

- a. Glucometer strips – Cost of blood glucose test strips is included as part of performing a Random Blood Sugar (RBS) test at bedside. No separate charge per strip is admissible if bedside glucose monitoring is done; it's covered under investigation or ward service.
- b. ECG leads/electrodes – included in the cost of an ECG. The hospital cannot charge for ECG electrodes or leads separately when billing for an ECG test.
- c. Ventilator circuits or consumables – when a patient is on a ventilator, the disposables (tubing, filters, circuits) are considered included in the ventilator charge. No separate line item for “ventilator consumables” should be billed.
- d. Ward facilities included in room charge: Items such as an air-bed, water bed, alpha bed or ripple mattress for bed sore prevention, routine air conditioning or heating charges, infusion pumps, DVT pump usage in ward, pulse oximeter or basic monitors, medical record photocopy charges, etc., are all included in the room/ward daily charge. They must not appear as separate charges.
- e. Issuance of Medical Records/Films: Providing the patient with discharge summary, lab reports, X-ray/CT/MRI films or CD copies of scans is part of the treatment rates. No fee should be charged for giving these to patient (aside from very exceptional cases like multiple copies of a large file, but even then WBHS don't pay for it).
- f. Vacutainers, syringes for investigations: Blood collection tubes, needles, lancets used for drawing samples are part of the lab test cost and not billable as separate “consumables” to WBHS.

Note: Essentially, any item that is by nature a part of performing a test or procedure or running a ward facility cannot be carved out to charge extra.
